GENERAL INFORMATION

HISTORY

Naval Kindergarten was commissioned in INS Rajali in June 1992. It started functioning in the old boy's hostel since 03 January 1994. The school started functioning from its own building since April 2002. The school was upgraded to Naval Public School on 07 April 1997, as a co-education institution and re-christened as Navy Children School (NCS) in April 2005. The school is affiliated to CBSE up to Senior Secondary School.

OBJECTIVES OF THE SCHOOL

The main aim of the school is to provide "child centered" quality education. It lays great emphasis on the all round development of the students through play way method of teaching & learning for KG students and activity based interactive learning for Primary students. In addition, to the given knowledge, it ignites a spark in their minds in order to develop thought-provoking processes and bring out the best in each one of them. The school endeavours, with the co-operation of the management and parents, to create the right environment, to achieve its objectives.

ADMINISTRATION

The school functions under the aegis of the Naval Education Society (NES), New Delhi. The Commanding Officer, INS Rajali is the Chairman of the Governing Body. The day-to-day management is looked after by the School Management Committee, the Vice Chairman, who is the Senior Education Officer, INS Rajali.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Period of admission: Registration forms are available with the school office in February/ March of the academic year.

Priority for Admission: The order of priority for admission is as follows:

- ✓ Category I Children of serving Naval Personnel
- ✓ Category II Children of serving Army/IAF personnel on deputation to Navy, serving Indian Coast Guard (ICG) personnel and NCS Staff
- ✓ Category III Children of retired Naval Personnel
- ✓ Category IV Children of serving and retired Army, IAF and retired ICG personnel
- ✓ Category V Children of Defence Civilian Personnel
- ✓ Category VI Others
 - For 'Retired personnel' mentioned in category III and IV, Naval personnel with minimum 15
 years of active service will be eligible. Personnel who do not qualify for this category will be
 accorded as Category VI.

Admissions are carried out as per dates promulgated by the school. Children of service personnel coming to INS Rajali on permanent transfer are given first preference.

For admission to class I, students should have completed **5 years** of age as on **31**st **March** of the year in which admission is sought. Similarly, those seeking admission to other classes should fulfill the corresponding age requirement. Admissions are done strictly on production of valid Birth Certificate of the child. No child more than the age bracket prescribed for a class would be admitted to the school.

WITHDRAWAL FROM SCHOOL

By Parent: One calendar month's notice is to be given with fees paid for the current month.

For poor academic performance: Poor performance in any class may be condoned in case of any genuine reasons like sickness, etc. but the student will be withdrawn from school in case of continued below average performance.

On disciplinary grounds: A student may be withdrawn from the school for bad conduct, considered detrimental to school discipline and if the student's continued presence is adjudged to be not in the interest of the school.

Non-Payment of fees: The student's name will be removed from the class nominal roll in the event of non payment of fees within the stipulated period.

TRANSFER CERTIFICATE

An application for Transfer Certificate is to be given at least a month in advance. Transfer Certificates will be issued only on clearance of all dues and surrendering of any library book issued and the return of the school identity card. A duplicate copy of Transfer Certificate is not ordinarily issued. In exceptional cases, a duplicate copy may be issued on production of an affidavit that the original Transfer Certificate has been irrevocably lost. The responsibility of any possible misuse will rest upon the parent.

In case of a cancellation of the Transfer Certificate, Rs 200/- will be charged as fine. The duplicate copy of the Transfer Certificate will be issued only on payment of Rs 100/- as fine.

INSTRUCTIONS TO PARENTS

- 1. Please read and understand the contents of this almanac and check it regularly for entries from the school. Also use the almanac for communication with the teachers.
- 2. Parents should furnish to the school their latest office, residential address and telephone numbers. These are vital in the interest of the safety of the student.
- 3. See that your ward carries textbooks/exercise books according to the time table of the day. Parents must glance through the textbooks, notebooks and answer papers of their children.
- 4. Parents should not call up teachers at their residence or at school unless it is a real emergency. The problems/doubts would be dealt by the school during visiting hours.
- 5. Children are prohibited from bringing crackers, colour powders etc. to the school. Bursting of crackers or playing with colours will make the student liable for suspension/expulsion from the school.

GETTING READY FOR SCHOOL

Kindly ensure that your children come to school smartly turned out. Points to be noted:

- ✓ Ensure your child brushes teeth, takes a bath and goes to the toilet every morning.
- ✓ Pin up name tags and handkerchief on the uniform shirt. (Class I)
- ✓ Girls are not allowed to use nail polish.
- ✓ Girls with short hair should use black/white hair band. Coloured bands and clips will be confiscated.
- ✓ Girls with long hair should make two plaits.
- ✓ Gold jewellery, bangles, bindis, flowers in the head, kajal, watches are not allowed in school.
- ✓ Uniforms should be clean and well ironed.
- ✓ Ensure that your wards wear under vests and underpants which protect the child.
- ✓ The length of the skirt should be knee length and not extend above the knee.
- ✓ T-Shirts are to be worn mid-thigh.
- ✓ Fancy haircuts like mushroom cuts for boys are not allowed.
- ✓ Hair should be maintained, as to not cover the forehead and eyes.
- ✓ Nails should be neatly clipped.
- ✓ Hair should be oiled and neatly combed.
- ✓ Socks should not be loose or tied up with rubber bands.
- ✓ Shoes should be polished.
- ✓ Shoes should be comfortable. Please do not let your children wear tight fitting shoes or loose shoes.
- ✓ In case of the student does not abide to instruction mentioned above, a fine of Rs.100 will be imposed.
- ✓ Girls should wear navy blue tights.

ACADEMICS

- ✓ Bag should be of the correct size to accommodate the books.
- ✓ Children should use only HB pencils.
- ✓ Erasers should be normal white and not perfumed.
- ✓ Fancy sharpeners are not allowed.
- ✓ Children should bring 6 inches plastic scale.
- ✓ Wooden and steel scales are not allowed.
- ✓ Fancy crayons or sketch pens are not allowed.
- ✓ Books and notebooks should be labelled with name, class and section.
- ✓ Mark all books with permanent marker pen.

EVENING CARE

- Pack school bag according to the time table and pencil box at night.
- Uniform to be kept ready including polishing of shoes.
- Extra books except the subjects mentioned in the timetable not to be brought.

LEAVE RULES

- 1. Regular attendance at the school is most essential.
- 2. Leave of absence is given to students on prior application from the parents. In unavoidable circumstances, the absence has to be regularized on the day of re-joining the school.
- 3. Those absent on account of illness are to submit a valid medical certificate.
- 4. All students are expected to attend the school on the re-opening day after any vacation.
- 5. Students suffering from any of the communicable diseases must re-join only with a certificate of fitness, after due period of quarantine.
- 6. Absence without leave for more than seven days is liable to result in the name of the student getting struck off the rolls. Readmission in such cases entails payment of all dues and fresh admission fees.

PTI MEETINGS

Experience has shown that many parents are indifferent to the progress, welfare and discipline of their wards, and in many cases awareness comes must to late, proving that home-school interaction is more vital. To fulfill this, PTI meetings are organised following the completion of every examination. Both Parents (father & mother) are advised to attend all PTI meetings and contribute to the well being of their wards.

RULES FOR STUDENTS

- (i) Navy Children Schools shall aim at behavioural elegance and inculcation of discipline in the students. Every parent and student should be apprised of the consequences for indulging in behaviour which is not permissible in the school.
- (ii) <u>Code of conduct for students.</u> The following acts and conduct on the part of students will amount to misconduct:-
 - (a) Misbehaviour towards teacher or any other employee of the school.
 - (b) Intentional disturbance of the classes.
 - (c) Continued absence from classes without the permission of the teacher / HM.
 - **(d)** Leaving the school premises or playground during school hours without prior permission of concerned teacher / HM.
 - (e) Bullying/intimidation of others.
 - (f) Eve-teasing / Adam –teasing misbehaviour towards girl/ boy students.
 - (g) Damaging / disfiguring of school property.
 - (h) Propagating a strike / disruption of classes.
 - (i) Association with banned organizations.
 - (j) Disobeying lawful orders of the teacher/ Principal.
 - (k) Bringing unauthorized people / articles inside the school.
 - (I) Theft/ pilferage of school/ student property.
 - (m) Involving in acts of moral turpitude.
 - (n) Smoking / consumption of alcohol/ any form of gambling.
 - (o) Use of drugs or intoxicants except on prescription by a registered medical practitioner.
 - **(p)** Use of violence in any form.
 - (q) Casteism, communication or practice of untouchability.
 - (r) Carrying any kind of weapon in the school premises.
 - **(s)** Improper use of computer resources of the school.
 - (t) In any case of misconduct the student will be awarded letter of displeasure signed by HM and counter signed by Vice Chairman and on the second instance they will be withdrawn from the school.

SCHOOL RULES

The following rules are to be strictly complied:

SCHOOL ALMANAC

- 1. The school almanac must be brought to the school every day.
- 2. All entries in the almanac from the school must be shown and signed by the parents
- 3. Entries made by the parents should be brought to the notice of the relevant school staff. The entry to be acknowledged by the school staff.
- 4. Almanac up to STD II will be signed by the class teacher everyday.

ATTENDANCE

- 1. Regular attendance to school is most essential. The minimum requirement of attendance in the academic year is 90%. A certificate of appreciation will be awarded to the students attaining 100% attendance.
- 2. Leave of absence is given to students on prior application from the parents.
- 3. Students absent on account of illness are to submit valid medical certificates.
- 4. Students suffering from the following diseases must observe the prescribed period of quarantine before returning to class:
 - a. Chicken pox till complete falling of scabs.
 - b. Cholera till the child is completely well.
 - c. Measles two weeks after the rash disappears.
 - d. Jaundice six weeks after recovery.
 - e. COVID-19 after COVID Negative Test.
- 5. A student returning to school after suffering from an infectious or contagious disease should produce a Fitness Certificate issued by a doctor, permitting him/her to attend the school.
- 6. Repeated absence without leave or unexplained absence for more than ten consecutive days renders the students liable to have his/her name struck off the rolls. Re-admission will be granted only on payment of fresh admission fee.
- 7. Appointment with doctors or any social engagements must not be arranged during school hours. No partial attendance will be permitted.

DISCIPLINE

- 1. Navy Children school students should display polite behavior wherever they go. They should always remember that the school is judged by their conduct.
- 2. Students should greet their teachers when they meet them.
- 3. The school has a "DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE' consisting of teachers, students and members of the PTA who will review disciplinary cases and award punishments on the lines prescribed by the NES.
- 4. Students are strictly prohibited from entering the school in civil dress. Unless the school has permitted during few celebrations.

PUNCTUALITY

- 1. All the students must be present in school before the scheduled time, i.e., 0745 hrs, as the assembly is at 0750 hrs. Both school gates will remain closed after 0745 hrs. upto 1400 hrs., in view of safety of the students from vehicles, stray dogs, pigs and other trespassers.
- 2. In view of the above, any student who brings a note from parents/guardian in the School Almanac explaining the reason for coming late will be allowed inside, after making an entry in the Register for Late comers. Habitual late comers have to meet the Headmistress, after 02 times late coming in the same month.
- 3. If the student comes late to school without a note from the parent/guardian, the following rule for punctuality will be followed on all the working days of the school:-

- 8. If you are in a moving vehicle, stop as quickly as possible and stay in the vehicle.
- 9. Free all pets and domestic animals so that they can run outside.
- 10. Extinguish all open flames like stoves, candles, lamps and matches.

IN CASE OF A FIRE

- 1. Do not panic.
- 2. Raise alarm/ inform the nearest teacher.
- 3. Switch off fans, lights, air-conditioners and computers etc.
- 4. Open doors and windows.
- 5. Do not run. Walk calmly down the stairs in a single file.
- 6. In case of heavy smoke, wet a towel or hanky using water from a water bottle. Then cover your nose and mouth with a wet towel or handkerchief and crawl out towards the nearest exit.
- 7. Assemble in an earmarked space at a safe distance and wait for instructions.
